ROLLING ADMISSIONS

BASIS Independent Bothell is accepting applications in our Rolling Admissions application cycle for K–Grade 9 for the 2025–2026 school year.

Rolling Application Deadline: Applications for all grades are open until the grade has closed. Once a grade has closed, qualified applicants will be placed in grade level wait pools.

Admissions Notifications: Within 10 business days of receiving your completed application.

Enrollment Agreement and Deposit Deadline: Within 10 business days of being offered a seat.

ADMISSIONS FAOS

- 1 | When can I schedule the required meetings? The Play Date or Entrance Exam and Family Meeting can be scheduled in your application portal.
- 2 | Is my child required to attend the Family Meeting? K—Grade 1 applicants are not required to attend. Applicants applying to Grade 2 and above are required to attend.
- 3 | Can I send you copies of my child's transcripts? In the application there is a Transcript Release Form to submit to your student's school, who will then send official transcripts directly to Admissions.
- 4 | My child has only one teacher for both English and math, what is the requirement? Please have your student's teacher fill out both the English and math recommendation forms.
