

For your records and further understanding, below is a copy of the terms you accepted and electronically signed when using our online system to enroll your child in our summer program.

Enrollment Agreement and Waiver – Summer Camp 2024

The School is relying on your consent to the terms of this (“Agreement”) in its operation generally and in allowing your child (the “Student” or your “child”), in particular, to attend the summer program.

The undersigned parents or guardians (the “Parents”) agree as follows:

- Refund Policy.** Deposits and program fees are refundable only as allowed in the School’s written refund policy and are otherwise non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another session or another student. This includes, but is not limited to, absence(s) and disruptive behavior or other misconduct.
- Discipline Expectations.** Parents agree that they and Students must abide by the School rules and any specific rules, regulations, policies, and codes of conduct and character set by program staff. The School reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to dismiss, exclude, or otherwise discipline any student from the activity or program who (i) does not meet the behavioral standards of the School, who violates program policies, or whose conduct at any time or place interferes with the program, or (ii) the School determines it to be in the best interests of the School. In the School’s sole discretion, dismissal may be with or without notice.
- Media Release.** Parents authorize the School, its affiliates, successors, and assigns to use Student’s image, voice, or work in any advertising or other media, and waive the right to inspect or approve prior to use. Parents may opt out of this provision by written notice to the School.
- Health and Safety.** Parents understand that the safety and security of all students is the School’s highest priority. Parents understand and agree that the School reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to implement policies to protect the health and safety of the School community. Parents authorize School staff to apply sunscreen to Student’s exposed skin on an as needed basis, if your child needs assistance.
- Illness and Emergency.** The School strives to maintain a healthy, safe environment for its students. In that light, students may not attend School while ill (as determined in the School’s sole discretion). Parents authorize the School to obtain immediate medical care if a medical emergency occurs when Parents cannot be located immediately.
- Assumption of Risk and Release; Responsibility.** Parents authorize and permit Student to attend and participate in all aspects of the program experience and activities. Parents understand that the School will exercise reasonable diligence to ensure the safety and well-being of Student during their participation; however, Parents also understand that it is not possible for the School to supervise all aspects of such activities at all times. Parents understand that there are inherent risks involved in such activities, and voluntarily assume and accept such arising from Student’s participation. Parents release the School, its affiliates, employees, and agents from all claims, liability, and damages that Parents or Student may have for personal injuries or property damage, loss or theft resulting from Student’s participation. Parents certify they have carefully read this agreement and fully understand its content. Further, Parents certify they are aware this is release of liability, and a contract between Parents and the School, and are signing it of their own free will.

- Responsibility for Your Child's Actions.** Parents must inform School personnel directly (and not through the Student) in the event there is a program activity in which they do not want your child to participate. Further, Parents take responsibility for any loss, damage, or destruction by Student of any property of the School or others and for any damages for which the School becomes liable or chargeable because of Student's actions.

- Responsibilities of Family.** A positive and constructive relationship among the School, Student, Parents, and Student's other family is essential to the fulfillment of the program. If the behavior, communication, or interaction on-campus, off-campus, or via electronic means, of Parents or other individuals interacting with the School and/or School community by virtue of their relationship with Student: (i) is disruptive, intimidating, overly aggressive; (ii) reflects a loss of confidence in or serious disagreement with the School, including but not limited to violation of or disagreement with School Policies, responsibilities, delivery of the program, strategic initiatives, personnel, or leadership; (iii) imperils accomplishment of its program; (iv) threatens the health, safety, or well-being of another member of the School community; (v) is otherwise inconsistent with commitments shared by members of the community; or (vi) fails to meet financial responsibilities to the School, Parents understand and agree that the School, in its sole discretion, has the right to dismiss Student from the School or implement other such restrictions.

- Student Digital Privacy.** From time to time the School may utilize various software applications and web-based services to deliver the best possible program to its students (the "Online Services"). In order to use the Online Services, students must often be registered in these systems using personally identifying information – generally their name, School email address, and/or a student ID. When using the Online Service, School faculty, staff, administrators, and other employees or agents may communicate with students electronically through e-mail, instant messaging services through the various Online Services, or through videoconference. By signing this Agreement, Parents consent to the Student's participation in Online Services and provide permission for School personnel to communicate with themselves and the Student via electronic communications. Parents further authorize the School to provide consent for the Student's use of the Online Services on Parents' behalf and to provide the Student's basic information to the Online Services when required to do so.

- Internet Use.** Parents recognize that, while the internet has the potential to provide vast resources and tremendous learning opportunities for students, searching the internet can expose students to dangerous or inappropriate material. Parents release the School and its employees from all claims, charges, and damages of any nature arising from use or misuse of the internet. Parents further agree that the School may condition Student's use of the internet upon execution by Parents and Student of further documentation as may be required by the School.

- Acts Beyond the School's Control.** Parents agree that in the event of any failure, delay, or modification in the School's performance or delivery of program under this Agreement resulting from causes beyond the School's reasonable control and occurring without its fault or negligence, including without limitation, acts of nature, fire, pandemic, epidemic, government restrictions, wars, and insurrections, the payment obligations under this Agreement shall continue and the School shall not be liable for any such failure or delay in its performance. If such an event occurs, the School's duties and obligations in this contract will be modified, suspended, or postponed until the School, in its sole discretion, may safely reopen or resume normal operations.

- Survival.** The following will survive expiration or termination of the Enrollment Agreement: Sections 3, 6, and any right or obligation of the Parents or School which, by its nature, should survive termination or expiration of this Agreement.
