Our seniors have two unique opportunities available to them: The Senior Project and the Senior Research Project. Both projects allow students to propose a research inquiry, execute intensive on-site and off-site research, and present a data-driven conclusion or solution. The Senior Research Project, in addition to documenting their findings, requires students to write a 4,000–5,000 word paper according to a rubric developed by the College Board. Both opportunities support our seniors' nascent sense of investigation and research, and require them to present their findings before their community.
