- 1 | Where can I schedule the required meetings? The Play Date or Entrance Exam and Family Meeting can be scheduled on your application portal.
- 2 | Who is required to attend the Family Meeting? PreK-Grade 1 applicants are not required to attend the Family Meeting. Applicants applying to grade 2 and above are required to attend the Family Meeting. At least one parent/guardian must attend.
- 3 | Can I send you copies of my child's transcripts? In the application there is a Transcript Release Form to submit to your student's school(s), who will then send official transcripts directly to Admissions.
- 4 | My child has only one teacher for both English and math; what is the requirement? Please have your student's current teacher fill out both the English and math recommendation forms.
