Below are the necessary steps to complete your child’s application.

ROLLING ADMISSIONS (Grades 5–10)

Application Opens: Thursday, January 29, 2026

Notification Date: Within 10 business days of receiving your completed application.

Commitment Deadline: Within 10 business days of being offered a seat.

Please note: Applying for Rolling Admissions is not immediately binding. To accept an offered seat, families must submit a signed Enrollment Agreement and a non-refundable deposit of \$2,000 by the Commitment Deadline.

ADMISSIONS FAQs

- 1 | Where can I schedule the required meetings?** The Entrance Exam and Family Meeting can be scheduled in your application portal.
- 2 | Who is required to attend the Family Meeting?** The student and at least one parent/guardian must attend.
- 3 | Can I send you copies of my child’s transcripts?** In the application there is a Transcript Release Form to submit to your student’s school(s), who will then send official transcripts directly to Admissions.
- 4 | My child has only one teacher for both English and math; what is the requirement?** Please have your student’s current teacher fill out both the English and math recommendation forms.
